The Membership Committee will then evaluate all nominations and pass its recommendations to MAC Council for action prior to the spring Council meeting. The awards will be presented at the members' meeting at the annual meeting.

Nominees for election to the status of Emeritus Member of the Midwest Archives Conference must be an individual member of MAC, retired from paid archival work, and have made a significant and substantial contribution to MAC during the course of his or her membership. To be considered, the individual has to have been a MAC member for a minimum of 10 years, though not necessarily consecutively. Significant or substantial service to MAC may include, but is not limited to, extensive or superior volunteer work in an elected or appointed role within MAC, and notable success in expanding the visibility and/or support of the Midwest Archives Conference.
