A service-based approach

- Be available
 Communication and flexibility are key
- Offer solutions
 Let them know what you can do!
- Provide resources
 Articles, guides, web resources, DIY

Know your audience



- Don't overwhelm them
- Understand what they want
 from you (and what they don't)

Keep expectations realistic



 Base recommendations on the available resources

- Use simple solutions
- Reduce barriers to implementation
